

How to Find Us

We are located across the river from Grant Narrows Regional Park, 1 hr from the international airport and 1.5 hrs from the US/Canada border. From the Lougheed Highway, turn north on Harris Rd in Pitt Meadows, right on Dewdney Trunk Rd, left on Neaves Rd and follow it to the end. The park gates are locked from dusk until 6 am.

A complimentary boat shuttle across the Pitt River is provided by Pitt Lake Wilderness Adventures. Please arrange a time for your shuttle pick-up when you make your reservation. Free parking is available at Grant Narrows Regional Park. Please make sure you get a parking pass from staff.

If you have your own boat you may moor at the dock at no additional charge (with cabin rental). Rental canoes are also available at Grant Narrows Regional Park.



Our staff will take your supplies close to the cabin by ATV for you and can transport guests that have trouble walking on gravel trails. Our site is not suitable for wheelchairs or those that have trouble walking on uneven ground and hills.

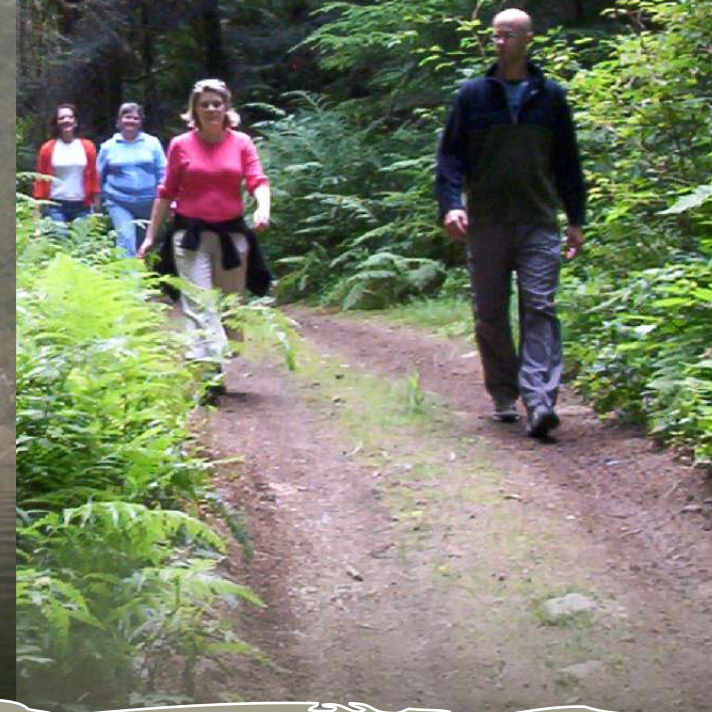

CABIN DESCRIPTIONS AND 2007 RATES

Osprey Cabin - A large porch, lakeside fire pit, mountain and lake views. Main cabin sleeps 2 in a double bed loft and 6 on couch beds. Adjacent guest cabin sleeps 2 more in a bed. Maximum suggested weekend capacity is 10, weekly 6.

May to September: \$160 daily, \$900 / wk.
Off-season: \$110/daily, \$600 / wk.

Sunshine Cabin - A large sunny porch, mountain and lake views. Cabin sleeps 2 in a bed and 2 on a couch bed. Maximum suggested weekend capacity is 6, weekly 4.

May to September: \$130 daily, \$750 / wk.
Off-season: \$100 daily, \$500 / wk.

Golden Ears Cabin - A porch with mountain and lake views. Cabin sleeps 2 in a bed and 2 on a couch bed. Maximum suggested weekend capacity is 6, weekly 4.

May to September: \$130 daily, \$750 / wk.
Off-season: \$100 daily, \$500 / wk.

Cedar Cove Cabin - A partially covered porch, mountain and lake views. Cabin sleeps 2 in a bed and 2 on a couch bed. Maximum suggested weekend capacity is 6, weekly 4.

May to September: \$130 daily, \$750 / wk.
Off-season: \$100 daily, \$500 / wk.

Edge Peak Cabin - A porch, mountain and lake views. Cabin sleeps 2 in a bed and two on a couch bed. Maximum suggested weekend capacity is 6, weekly 4.

May to September: \$130 daily, \$750 / wk.
Off-season: \$100/daily, \$500 / wk.

Forest Cabin - A small porch, limited mountain and lake views. Cabin sleeps 2 in a bed and 2 on a couch bed.

May to September: \$100 daily, \$500 / wk.
Off-season: not available.

What you need to bring - Food, drinking water, sleeping bags, good footwear, appropriate clothing, camera.

Current Facilities

6 renovated lakeside cabins with mountain views into Golden Ears Provincial Park. Each cabin is furnished and has a gas fireplaces or heater, fridge, stove, dishes and cooking utensils. Each cabin has its own odour-free composting toilet and solar powered lights.

Natural Unique Features

- Largest freshwater tidal wetland in south-western BC with national, provincial and regional significance
- Pitt Lake is the largest freshwater tidal lake in North America
- Significant wildlife viewing opportunities adjacent to the Pitt-Addington Wildlife Management Area, Pinecone Burke Provincial Park, Golden Ears Provincial Park, Widgeon Valley National Wildlife Area
- Widgeon Slough and waterfalls (canoe access and hiking trails)
- Deer, black bear and other wildlife are often found in the area, please use appropriate precautions when hiking away from your cabin and in the storage of your food.
